A-1 Audio Engineer

Summary Statement:

The A-1 Audio Engineer is responsible for setting up, operating and maintaining audio equipment at entertainment venues, and in the recording studio. The position reports to the Recording Studio Manager/Chief Recording Engineer.

Essential Functions:

The essential functions of the A-1 Audio Engineer are core common functions as listed and are not restricted to the following functions:

- Ability to operate audio consoles and set up for live shows and recording studio.
- Ability to design layouts of audio equipment and perform upgrades and maintenance.
- Ability to install, adjust and operate electronic equipment used to record, and edit live programs.
- Ability to maintain inventories of audio recordings and related supplies.
- Ability to mix and regulate sound outputs and feeds, or coordinate audio feeds.
- Ability to perform repairs and routine cleaning of audio equipment.
- Ability to record and edit audio materials using audio recording and editing equipment.
- Ability compress, digitize. Duplicate and store audio data.

Job Requirements:

The incumbent will possess:

- Associates or Technical Degree in a related field, experience and education will be considered.
- Five plus years experience operating and maintaining audio equipment preferred.
- Experience with computer systems to include hardware and software.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Experience creating graphics, industrial artistry or design work.
- Ability to lift/push/pull 50 pounds.
