Lighting Technician

Summary Statement:

Under the Director of the Lighting Director, the Lighting Technician is responsible for routine maintenance of lighting equipment, proper placement of lighting instruments at various on-site entertainment venues.

Essential Functions:

The essential functions of the Lighting Technician are core common functions as listed and are not restricted to the following functions:

- Maintain a clean safe work environment.
- Ability to perform routine maintenance and safety checks of all equipment.
- Assist Lighting Director in equipment inventory, repair, maintenance of lighting and special effects equipment for on-site and off-site venues.
- Ability to identify lighting various lighting equipment and utilize appropriate application.
- Ability to load and unload equipment from trucks.
- Ability to maintain manual and computerized logs.
- Ability to work with other departments on special lighting projects.
- Ability to hang and focus lighting equipment.
- Ability to perform other duties as assigned.
- Ability to foster and maintain positive professional relationships with customers, peers and managers.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.

Job Requirements:

The intern Will demonstrate:

- One year undergraduate education with successful completion of coursework in Lighting Design, Lighting Technology, or Technical Drawing.
- A basic understanding of wiring and electricity.
- A working knowledge and experience with modern lighting equipment.
- Knowledge of Audio, Video, Lighting Systems.
- Flexibility and ability to work within tight deadlines.
- Organization and attention to detail.
- Effective written and verbal communication skills.
- The ability to lift/push/pull 50 pounds.
